

BELGIAN FIGURE SKATING CHAMPIONSHIPS 2025 ANNOUNCEMENT

The Belgian National Championships will take place on Friday 17th and Saturday 18th of januari 2025, at IJsbaan Sport Vlaanderen Hasselt De Schaverdijn, Gouverneur Verwilghensingel 13, 3500 Hasselt, \$\frac{1}{2}\$ +32 11 300800.

The Free skating of the category Intermediate Novice and the Short Program of the categories Advanced Novice, Junior and Senior will take place on Friday.

The Free Skating of the category Basic Novice will take place on Saturday morning.

The Free Skating of the categories Advanced Novice, Junior and Senior will take place on Saturday evening.

For the category Senior Women, skaters participating at the European Championships who can't compete on January 17th and 18th because of the busy calender, **their scores obtained at the Golden Spin 2024 in Zagreb will be taken into account** for the Belgian Championships.

ENTRIES

Entries for the Belgian Figure Skating Championships need to be sent to **secnat@telenet.be** and in copy to **the regional secretary** using the most recent entry form (see www.skatebelgium.be). Entries will be accepted until **Wednesday december 11**th **2024, 23:59** (closing date).

Skaters who obtain a level upgrade at a competition after the closing date and thereby also qualify to enter the Championships, will additionally be allowed to enter. Such entries will be accepted, however, only if a preliminary entry is made before the closing date so the skater can be taken into account for the timetable, and the entry is confirmed within three (3) days after the official communication of the level upgrade. No exceptions will be made.

Entry fees:

Basic Novice, Intermediate Novice: 75 euro (Free Skating only)

Advanced Novice, Junior, Senior: 110 euro (Short Program + Free Skating)

Clubs will receive an invoice from the KBKF/FRBPA treasury. Make sure all payments are made before the date mentioned on the invoice. Entries can be refused if not paid in full.

MUSIC AND PLANNED ELEMENTS

Music and planned elements will be used from the national databases.

If program music and/or planned elements have changed, make sure to update the database as mentioned in the respective KBKF/FRBPA Communications.

TECHNICAL REGULATIONS

Categories will **NOT** be divided in subcategories regardless the number of participants.



STARTING ORDER

Basic Novices and Intermediate Novices (Free Skating) Advanced Novices, Junior and Senior (Short Program)

Starting order will be determined by draw.

Advanced Novices, Junior and Senior (Free Skating)

The starting order will be in reverse order of the Short Program ranking.

CITIZENSHIP REQUIREMENTS

Skaters who do not have (obtained) the Belgian nationality will be required to have obtained a Clearance certicate from the I.S.U. to enter the Belgian championships. First time participants who do not have the Belgian nationality can be accepted on condition the fully completed and signed release and clearance application has been sent to the national secretary at secgen.kbkf@telenet.be.
