Invited members The competition includes following categories:

B Competition (free program only):

Categories: Preminiemen, Miniemen, Basic Novice , Intermediate Novice , Advanced Novice (free only), Junior (free only) and

Senior (free only).

Participation in these categories is only open to competitors affiliated

to Belgian Clubs.

The competition is for Girls and Boy.

Adult International Competition:

Adults Bronze, Adults Silver, Adults Gold and Adults Master.

Participation is open to all skaters reached at least the age of sixteen (16) by July 1st preceding the competition for Ladies and Men for all categories who belong to an ISU Member.

Age categories for all adults categories:

- Young Adults Free Skating: Skaters have reached at least the age of sixteen (16) by 1st July preceding the competition for Ladies and Men ad for all categories. Skaters have not reached the age of twenty-three (23) by 1st July preceding the competition for Ladies and Men and for all categories.
- Pre Adults Free Skating: Skaters have reached at least the age of twenty-three (23) by 1st July preceding the competition for Ladies and Men ad for all categories. Skaters have not reached the age of twenty-eight (28) by 1st July preceding the competition for Ladies and Men ad for all categories.
- Adults Free Skating: Skaters have reached at least the age of twenty-eight (28) by 1st July preceding the competition for Ladies and Men ad for all categories.

The competition is for Ladies and Men.

Remark: In case there is not a complete podium in an age category, this one would be merged with another age category of the same technical level.

Entrance Fee

The entrance fee is:

- 75 € for single skaters (Free Skating only)

Entries

Belgian Clubs:

Foreign Clubs:

Entries must be done using enclosed Excel forms sheets.

Completed entry forms should be mailed to cpla.secretariat@gmail.com, the club secretary

Closing date

Entries will be accepted until Sunday September 8th, 14:00.

Inscriptions will not be closed prior to the closing date, regardless the number of entries received.

Limitations

In case the number of entries exceeds the maximum capacity, the participants will be determined by a draw on Wednesday September 11th, 10h00, in accordance with the KBKF/FRBPA competition regulations.

There will be no limitation for the organizing club and foreign skaters.

The drawn of the rejected entries will be random in all categories at the same time.

The organizing committee will confirm the participants by email **one** week after the closing date at the latest. An invoice will follow the confirmation.

Judges

Each participating foreign club has the right to propose at the least a national level qualified judge.

Names of the candidates are sent to cpla.secretariat@gmail.com before the closing date.

The organizing committee will provide all judges with food and lodging, as well as compensations according to FRBPA Comm 2022.13.

Time Table

The time table will be published as soon as available on the federations website www.skatebelgium.be . Please (re-)check for possible changes when approaching the day of the competition.

During the competition, minor modifications related to the time table can be made due to organizational circumstances.

The timetable will also mention all Price Awarding Ceremonies.

Starting Order

For each category, the starting order will be determined by draw. The draw will be done by computer prior to the competition. As soon as available, it will be published on the federation website www.skatebelgium.be.

Awarding Ceremony

All participants must be present in their competition costume for the announcement of the results and the prize awarding ceremony.

In case of absence during the awarding ceremony, no trophees will be provided.

Skaters, coaches and supporters may book travel arrangements and accommodations individually and at their own expense.

We recommend contracting cancellation insurance in case the number of entries exceeds the maximum capacity.
