
KRISTALCUP SOLISTEN - A (BNO/INO) & B competition

Starting Order	For each category, the starting order will be determined by draw. The draw will be done by computer prior to the competition.
Registration	All competitors must register in person , at the info desk upon arrival, presenting their identity card or Kids ID .
	Competitors entered in the first category of the competition day must register between 06:30 and 07:00 AM .
	All other competitors must register one hour before the start of their category at the latest .
	Coaches must visibly wear a valid coaches license to enter the neutral zone.
Awarding Ceremony	All participants must be present in their competition costumes for the announcement of the results and the prize awarding ceremony.
	There will be separate awarding ceremonies for the different categories.
	In case of an unannounced absence during the awarding ceremony, no trophy's or medals will be provided.
Accommodation	Skaters, coaches and supporters may book travel arrangements and accommodations individually and at their own expense.
