Technical Data

<u>Venue</u> : Ice Rink Sportoase Groot Schijn Ruggeveldlaan 488, 2100 Deurne (Antwerp) - Belgium

The ice rink is a covered rink, skating area 60m x 30m.

The ice rink catering, Foodmaker, offers a wide variety of healthy snacks, salads, sandwiches and hot meals. Foodmaker does not allow bringing in your own food and drinks

Hair and make-up need to be done in the designated areas.

Car parking is sufficiently available at the ice rink. Parking cost 2.50€ max for a whole day

The marking system (ISU judging system) will be used in accordance with the respective ISU Communications. The competition will be conducted in accordance with the latest KBKF/FRPBA regulations for international Interclub Acompetitions. Invited members

<u>The International Interclub A-competition</u> includes following categories : (National and foreign skaters)

Basic Novice, Intermediate Novice : Free only

Advanced Novice, Junior : short and free

Senior ladies (short and free) will only be included in the competition when there are at least 5 entries.

Senior men (short and free) will only be included in the competition when there are at least 5 entries. Clubs will be invited from all over the world.

Every invited club has the right to enter 8 skaters per category They can also enter substitutes for this category.

The substitutes will be able to compete if there aren't enough competitors for the category concerned or in case of injury from an announced participant.

The organizing committee will inform the clubs in time in such case. There are no limitations in the other categories.

The organizing club has the right to enter more participants.

The organizing club will follow the order mentioned on the entry form and there will be no further correspondence about these subscriptions.

In case of a too high number of entries, the organizers reserve the right to limit the entries according to the maximum capacity of the ice

It will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2024, the ISU Special Regulations and Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2024 and the relevant ISU Communications. The Novice Categories will be held in accordance with ISU communications and subsequent updates. (Can be changed after the ISU June 2024 Congress)

Participation is open to all competitors who belong to an ISU Member and qualify with regards to eligibility, according to Rule 102, provided their age falls within the limits specified in Rule 108. (depending the rules after the June 2024 Congress)

The competition is considered to be an "Interclub Competition with participation of Skaters from at least two ISU Members" as per Rule 107 (14) of the ISU General Regulations. depending the rules after the June Congress 2024)

Competitors will be entered by the clubs and will represent the clubs. Foreign competitors therefore do not require any clearance certificate.

Entrance Fee

The entrance fee is :

- 75 € for single skaters (Free Skating only).
- 110 € for single skaters (Short Program + Free Skating)

Belgian Clubs

Entries must be made using the Excel form available on KBKF website:. Please make sure to use the drop-down menus to select club and all skaters.

Foreign Clubs:

Entries must be done using enclosed Excel forms sheets.

Entries Judges/Controller's

Each participating foreign club has the right to propose a at least National or International level qualified judge/technical controller. Entries from a foreign club bringing a judge/technical controller will have the priority in case of too many entries.

Names of the candidates are sent to <u>secretariaat@icediamonds.be</u> before the closing date.

The organizing committee will provide all judges with food and lodging, as well as compensations according to K.B.K.F. Comm 2022.13.

Closing date

Entries will be accepted until Friday, September 27th 2024 - 18:00.

Inscriptions will **not** be closed prior to the closing date, regardless the number of entries received.

Limitations

In case the number of entries exceeds the maximum capacity, the participants **will be determined by draw on** Wednesday, October 9th 2024 - 18:30 at ice rink 'Sportoase Deurne' in accordance with the KBKF/FRBPA competition regulations.

The draw to select the rejected entries will be in the following order :

Random draw within the participants of the competition, regardless of their nationality.

There will be no limitations for the organizing club and its guest skaters

Foreign clubs bringing a judge will be prioritized.

The organizing committee will confirm the participants from all competitions by mail on Saturday October 12th 2024. An invoice will be sent.

Payments

If payments aren't received in full on Saturday October 19th 2024, the organizing club has the right to cancel or replace the skater(s) concerned.

Please keep in mind that bank transfers can take a few days.

Planned Elements will be used from the national database.

Participants whose planned elements have changed need to update the database **15 days before the first competition day at the latest**.

During the competition, minor modifications related to the time table can be made due to organizational circumstances.

For each category, the starting order will be determined by draw.

The draw will be done by computer prior to the competition.

As soon as available, it will be published on the federation website <u>www.skatebelgium.be</u> and will also be sent to foreign clubs.

Registration

All competitors must register in person, every competition day, at the info desk upon arrival, presenting their identity card or Kids ID.

Competitors entered in the first category of the competition day must register **at latest 30min before the start of the category**

All other competitors must register <u>one hour before the start of</u> <u>their category at the latest.</u>

Coaches must visibly wear a valid trainers license to enter the neutral zone.

The info desk will be in place on the second floor at the entrance of Foodmaker

Awarding Ceremony

All participants must be present in their competition costumes and skates for the announcement of the results and the prize awarding ceremony. These can be on-ice or off-ice.

There will be partial awarding ceremonies for the categories who skated in the morning before lunch-time.

In case of absence during the awarding ceremony, no trophies or medals will be provided.

Photographic pictures of the awarding ceremonies will be taken by the organizing club and might be published on local and/or social media. When entering, competitors agree with taking and publishing these pictures.

COVID-19 regulations

During the competition, COVID-19 safety measures by national and/or local health authorities may (still) apply. If so, these measures will be indicated and should be met at all times. All participants and club secretaries will be informed in advance regarding such measures.

When showing any symptoms of the COVID-19 virus (such as fever, coughing or trouble breathing), or in case you recently have been in contact with a person who acquired the virus, you should prioritize your health and the health of those around you. You will therefore not be allowed to participate in the competition.
